
RECOVERY CONNECTION



Our Pilot Program Spotlight is on **Ground 40** located in Monroe, N.C. Our program helps men transition back into the community from homelessness, addiction, and incarceration. This is facilitated through discipleship and educating them on strong biblical principles through a practical three stage process: The Farm, The Ranch, and The Homes.



Our Program

We have a 3 to 5 phase program with a minimum stay of 6 months and maximum is 2.5 years. Men enter our program through our intake line and cohort process. We bring all the men into the program at the same time rather than staggered to start the process of 180 days together - all in unison. Our cohort size is about 12 to 16 men. The first phase is The Farm, and it is abstinence from any substances from the beginning. It is a safe place. They stay and work at The Farm for 40 days then an assessment is completed after 40 days. They then move to The Ranch to provide community service work. They go to church on Tuesday and Wednesday nights.


GROUND 40 SPOTLIGHT

From The Ranch. residents go to the Restoration House. where thev provide volunteer labor like taking care of widows and orphans, and work to build back communities that we have taken so much from. They go through counseling and live in transitional housing. Then, we have a post transitional house for those that come from other parts of the state. This is for men that are in good standing with the community and have a good job. This is a healthy, successful transition to the community when they are ready.

One can be successful and can be effective our goal is to be effective. These men are fathers, husbands, sons, brothers and uncles, and we walk through life with them. One of the worst things that can happen is for the wife and children to be neglected - she is bankrupt in every aspect, but he is doing great in our program. A healthy man is going back into a healthy situation as our program encompasses the whole family with support offered to those members inside and outside the formal 'residential program'. The whole family's needs addressed support all members to associated with the individual's recovery.

Most people can maintain sobriety when they are chained to a rock, but they often fail when going back into the environment and relationships that lead them to drug use. Lastly, once our men graduate from our free, 6 month program, they then have the opportunity to move into one of our transitional homes. This is where they get the chance to live on their own, while still having accountability, working, and being back in the community.


LEADERSHIP FELLOWS ACADEMY

- 4. Community (peer, family, and other social supports)







We launched Aspire on May 1, 2025. 105 multidimensional survey assessments have been completed. Below are data measures tracking Social Drivers of Health and Well-Being for recovery residents. CRCI Aspire Coaches are actively working with residents to address the red and yellow indicators with S.M.A.R.T. - Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant and Time-Bound Goals.
